

OUR TRIPS

We are known across the nation for our "Island" trips. Exploring the pristine waters of the Channel Islands are our specialty. Using stable, safe, sit-on-top kayaks, even new paddlers can experience the excitement and beauty of the islands most unique feature - it's sea caves. On Santa Cruz Island alone, there are dozens of secret caves and pocket coves, some just large enough to fit a kayak, and our guides know them all. This is an ideal trip for groups sized from 6-24. We provide all the gear, the

kayaks and Coast Guard approved boat transportation.



Apart from our "Island" trips, we also offer harbor trips (about 2 hours) and one-way down-the-coast excursions, where a group can

depart on the beach right in front of their hotel. We can also provide sunset paddles and even full moon paddles. Half and full day trips from Gaviota to El Capitan are also available. Call us for a quote. Group rates available.

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OUR RENTALS

From one hour to one week, choose from our fleet of safe, stable sit-on-top kayaks available to rent. Kayaks can be picked up from our shop or our beach rental locations.

We provide free basic instruction and advice on trip routes to best enjoy our local water. Wetsuit and paddle jackets are also available to rent. Rentals start at \$20 for two hours for single kayaks and \$30 for two hours tandems.
