

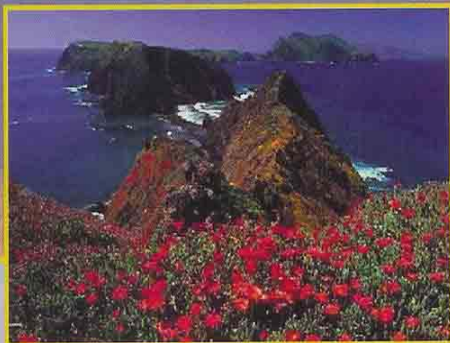

Explore the Galapagos of North America!

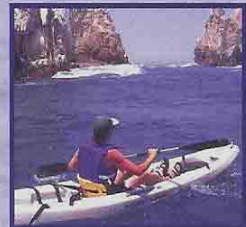
In the Santa Barbara Channel you will enter one of the world's most biodiverse marine environments. Each year our waters are home to thousands of migrating whales, from grays to humpbacks, orcas and even giant blue whales. On many trips we encounter huge pods of friendly dolphins and porpoises, who respond when you call and love to play alongside the boat. At remote San Miguel Island you can come alongside the only beach in the world where six species of pinnipeds - seals, sea lions and elephant seals - breed and calve together. Rare



brown pelicans and red-tailed hawks nest on the islands' steep cliffs, while the crystal clear waters below are filled with corals, starfish, shells and big and small fish of every color imaginable.

The experience of a lifetime!

You'll treasure so many memories of this amazing place. Conditions permitting you could be kayaking inside the famous sea caves of Santa Cruz Island ... snorkeling with inquisitive young seals ... exploring deserted coves ... interacting with whales and dolphins ... sipping your cold drink on deck as you dry off after a swim ... feeling you've traveled to a different place, an earlier time, a more innocent world, that few are privileged to know. Your vessel for the day is a modern Seasport motor yacht built in Washington state and designed especially for your safety and comfort. Amenities include full galley (and barbeque grill!), hot shower and bathroom facilities. Your captain is a veteran mariner licensed by the US Coast Guard, and all crewmembers are local residents familiar with the history, culture, and flora and fauna of the region.

Rates start at \$450 for a half-day charter; \$700 for a full day. There is a fixed price to charter the boat, so come as a couple, or with friends, up to six people.
